

## Are You My Mother? Rubrics

### Pre-Assessment Rubric for Analyzing Student Post-It Responses in Writing

Level	Indicators
<b>4</b> <b>Above grade level</b>	The student can independently generate 2 or more descriptive sentences about the image.
<b>3</b> <b>On grade level</b>	The student can independently generate 1 descriptive sentence about the image.
<b>2</b> <b>Below grade level</b>	The student can generate 1 descriptive sentence about the image with teacher support. <b>OR</b> The student can list 2 or 3 descriptive words about the image on his/her post-it note without teacher support.
<b>1</b> <b>Significantly below grade level</b>	The student requires a great deal of teacher support to complete the task. <b>OR</b> The student is only able to complete the task independently by copying directly from the anchor chart.

### Rubric for Analyzing Student Response Sheets

Level	Indicators
<b>4</b> <b>Above grade level</b>	The student can independently generate 4 or more descriptive sentences about the images.
<b>3</b> <b>On grade level</b>	The student can independently generate 3 descriptive sentences about the images.
<b>2</b> <b>Below grade level</b>	The student can generate 2 descriptive sentences about the images with teacher support. <b>OR</b> The student can list some descriptive words for each image on his/her paper without teacher support.
<b>1</b> <b>Significantly below grade level</b>	The student requires a great deal of teacher support to complete the task. <b>OR</b> The student is only able to complete the task independently by copying directly from his/her partner's chart.
